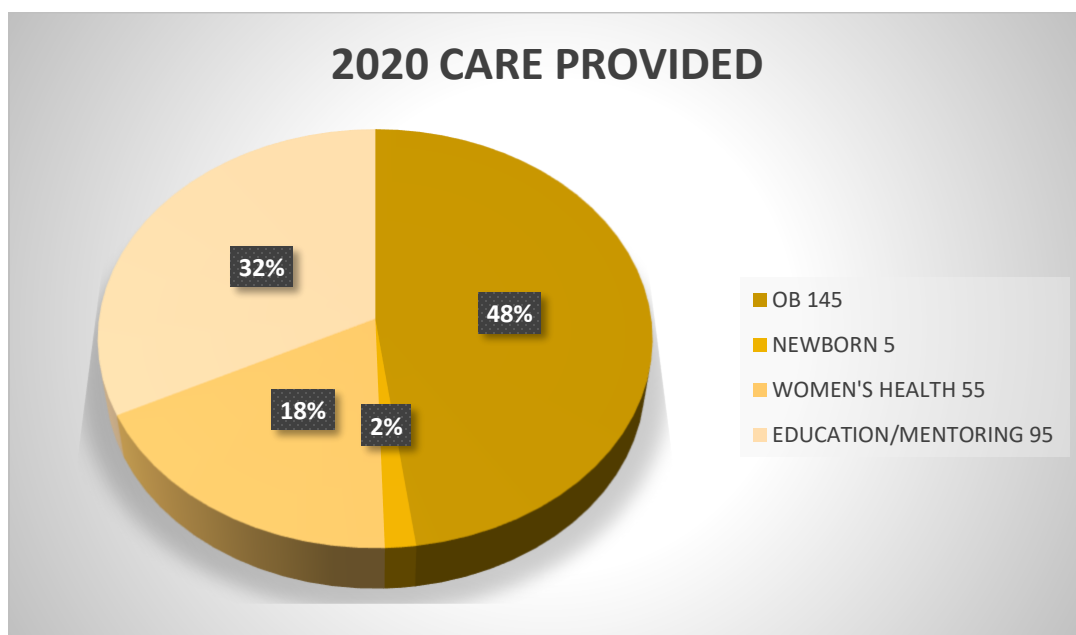

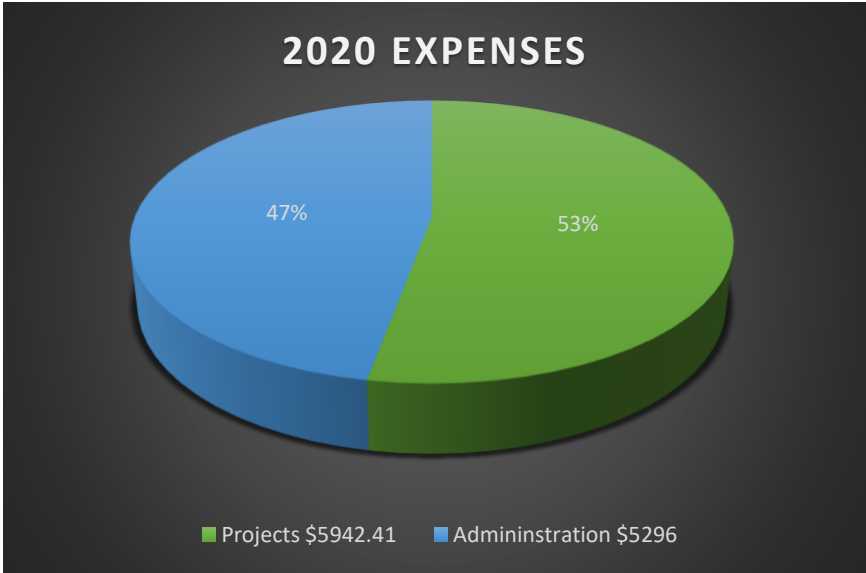
Our Work

In 2020, four midwives provided care in Kenya and India before all programming came to an abrupt halt in March.



Our education program included mentoring of local providers and skill workshops. Our midwives also provided education to families and local communities. In addition, Midwife Pilgrim, Inc. provided updated COVID-19 guidelines to ensure our global partners were safe.
